~ Drive around day information and safety sheet ~

To help you make the most of your day and to keep you and others as safe please observe the following:-

- The site speed limit is 10 mph
- You must remain within the site perimeter at all times
- Be aware that there are other vehicles and members of the public on the site at the same time, please remain alert and courteous
- There may be some 'out of bounds' areas, these will be taped off, please do not enter these areas
- We may be running an RTV (4x4 trial) event on the site today, if so you are welcome to observe however please do not move any of the marker canes or interfere with the sections. Once the section has been used by us the canes will be removed and you are free to use that area
- Please 'walk' any areas of the site that are un-familiar before attempting to drive them. Please do not attempt to drive any areas or sections that you are not confident of achieving safe passage
- You will find natural hazards around the site these may include deep water and mud, trees and un-even surfaces be cautious, be careful of yourselves, your vehicle and any other member of the public, you are here at your own risk
- DO NOT TOUCH OR ALLOW ANY OTHER MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC TO TOUCH ANY MILITARY DEBRIS. REPORT IT TO A MARSHALL IMMEDIATELY.
- Seat belts must be worn at all times whilst your vehicle is in motion
- Observe all instructions given by our marshals
- If you become 'stuck' please attempt to recover yourself in the first instance, if you are unable to achieve a safe recovery please contact a marshal for assistance
- In the unlikely event of a vehicle roll over please contact a marshal immediately
- Please keep any bystanders away from vehicles being recovered
- If you experience or observe a fire of any type please contact a marshal immediately (we recommend that you carry your own fire extinguisher, however if you do not have one we do)
- Both your vehicle recovery points and any recovery equipment may be inspected prior to entry to assess their suitability (shackles must be rated to a minimum of 3.5 tonne)
- Kinetic ropes are not permitted
- If your vehicle breaks down contact a marshal for recovery to a safe area
- Please do not litter the site, do not dig any holes and no fires are allowed
- Please do not dig any holes
- Only use established tracks please do not forge new tracks or break any banks
- We reserve the right to remove any driver/vehicle not following the above or deemed to be a danger to him/herself or others
- Do not leave any valuable unattended
