UPDATE?

A reasonable size box trailer, big enough to house the canes and markers etc. and to contain a small table for signing-on etc, will normally cost upwards of £1000, second-hand. So how do we save the money? You're reading stage one! Members have been quite adamant that some sort of communication each month is vital; so this sheet would be produced bi-monthly, alternating with the full-size "Pants & Berks". "Update" will cost a fraction of the of the full-size magazine and this alone could save us around £1000 a year. Believe it or not, twelve copies of Pants & Barks for every member costs over £2500 total each year. Six P&Bs and six "Updates" would cost around £1500. Savings = 1 trailer.

So where do we go from here? Well, Alan Smith has bought a superb trailer for around £800, generously using his own resources rather than miss the bargain deal. The trailer is a twin-axle 10 foot long, 6 foot wide, 6½ foot high box trailer with two doors, a window and a rear hatch. Alan has also offered to store the trailer in a safe place - in an area easily accessible to many members to collect on their way to the events. How can we refuse? The fate of the caravan has yet to be decided but I know at least one member (name not noted) has asked for a couple of the windows to restore his own van. Please can he contact one of the committee.
