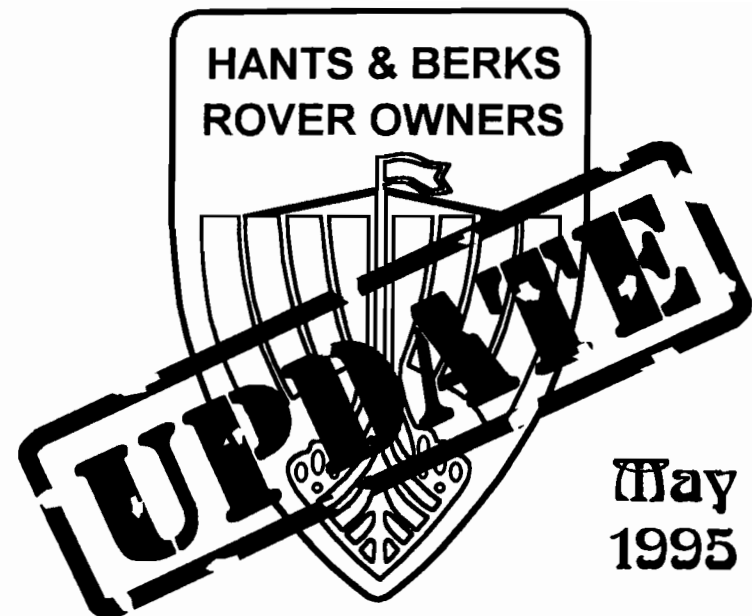

Dear Steve,

You might be interested in a trip we're planning to make from Land's End to John O'Groats, starting Saturday the 8th of April. We have the back seats out of the Discovery (a three door Tdi) for sleeping space, and a Caranex tent extension for living(?) and storage room overnight. Preparations:- We're taking most of the tools I own, a good first aid kit and fire extinguishers, but we're light on recovery equipment: two jacks, two heavy towropes and a shovel! But we do have good (ocean-going) foul weather gear and will be carrying ten days worth of food and a (marine-band) radio against the possibility of being snowed-in for a few days.

I've checked all the sites and they're happy with a Land Rover / tent combination. Charges vary from £7-50 to £10.00 a night without electricity. Two places, Pennybont (Bala) and Edithmead (Burnham-on-Sea), required booking and a deposit. One place, Edithmead, asked me if I was over fifty. Presumably they need to work out how many ambulances they'll need if everyone on the site over fifty croaks on the same night! If anything interesting happens I'll try to write it up for the Newsletter.
