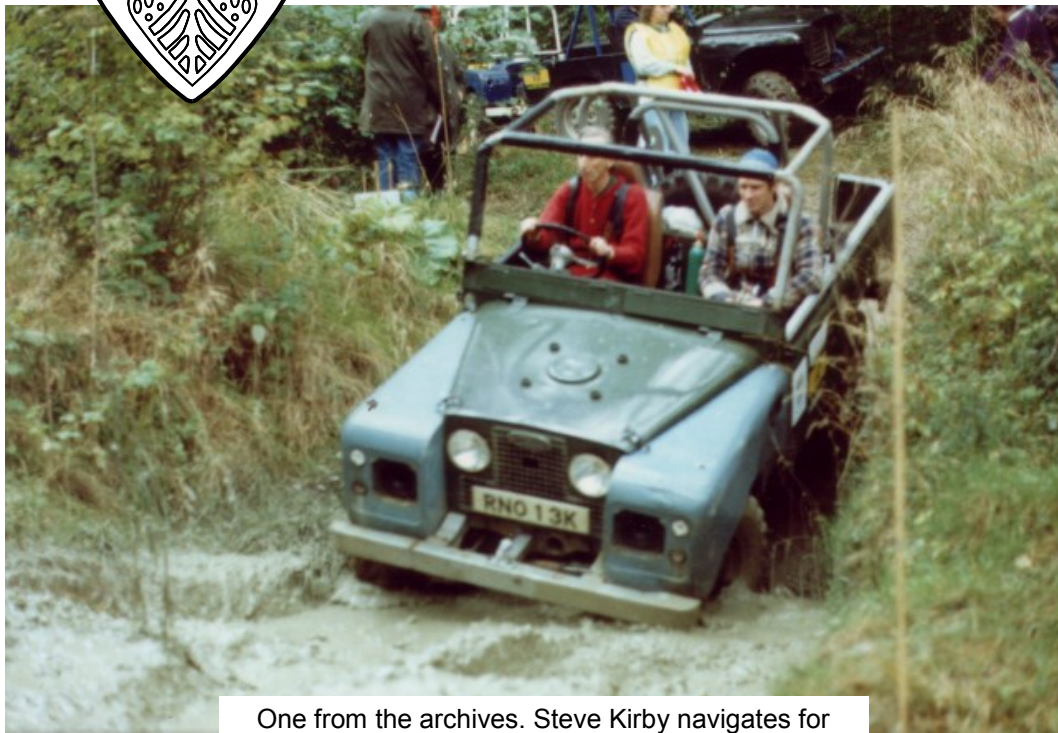

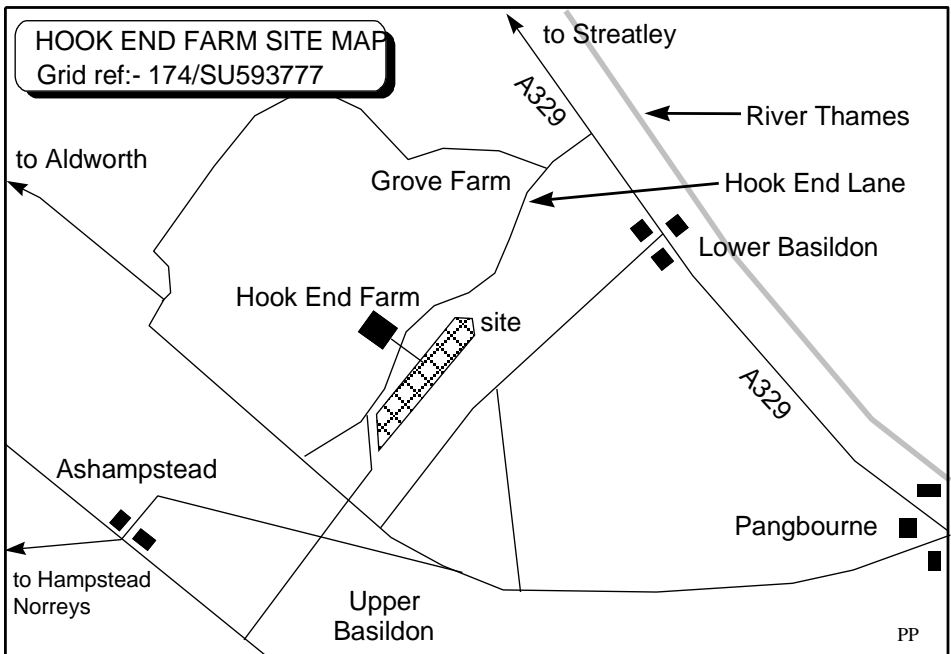

Entry is £35 per vehicle, and **IS PREBOOKED ONLY** this will cover you and your passenger, (and you must be a paid up member of HBRO, if not then its £35 plus membership !)
